

LEAGUES FOR HPRAI MEMBERS POLICY

Below are general guidelines that pertain to leagues formed for members of HPRAI. These guidelines can be amended at any time for whatever reason by the HPRAI Board of Directors.

Membership dues must be paid by the first day of league play. This is a HPRAI policy rule and also a league rule. Leagues must be open to all that have paid memberships in full.

Leagues must be a minimum of 6 teams (12 persons) to constitute a league.

Dates on which league play will begin shall be determined by the director of the specific league with the consent of the Course Superintendent. The ending date of a league will be determined by the league director and should not extend past a date when a majority of the league members are not playing on the designated league day.

Wednesdays will be the designated weekday for women's league. Thursdays will be the designated weekday for men's league. Fridays will be the preferred weekday for couples' league, but such league play may be scheduled at any time that does not interfere with other league play. Open golfing on designated league days by greens-fee paying guests is allowed, subject to the pace of play of league players. Open golfing by any member on designated league days is only allowed before league play begins for the day, after league play ends for the day or during a break in league play.

Leagues should golf during their designated play time. Each league should finish and be off the course before another league's play time starts.

If a Tournament or Event Day is scheduled on a league day, a Tournament or Event Day Request Form must be completed and submitted to the Board of Directors for approval. This form must be signed by the President or Directors of any league whose play time would be affected by the play of the Tournament or Activities Day.

Leagues shall determine their own rules, dues, and games of play and shall be responsible for managing the operation of the league and its members. The HPRAI Board of Directors' authority for the internal operation of any league is limited to enforcing its own general rules and policies.

HPRAI Board of Directors will honor written agreements between leagues that differ from this League Policy, if such written agreement is signed by Presidents and/or Directors of all leagues involved. Any written agreement cannot make an exception from a policy for one or a few individuals or individual circumstances. Exception to any policy must apply to all members of all leagues involved.

Should league members experience a problem or infraction, they should report to their President or Director. The President or Director will contact the HPRAI Board of Directors with a written description of the event or infraction and those persons involved, if the event or infraction comes under the Board's jurisdiction.

The Caddy Shack staff cannot change rules nor make exceptions and has no authority to enter into any debate between leagues.
